


B2K School Readiness Action Team Highlights

August 2022 - July 2023



The B2K (Birth to Kindergarten) Action Team's mission is to ensure that every child in Geneva starts

Kindergarten with the skills and experience needed to succeed in school, and that systems are in place to ensure that every parent/guardian has access to, is aware of, and is connected to the services they need.

First 1000 Days Promise partnership

- B2K Team actively supports daily Toddler Time and Super Saturdays at the Community Center. Hot breakfasts are served, food, supplies, books and toys are distributed. An 8 week series of parent coaching sessions was provided.
- 300 families (450 children) are currently enrolled
- B2K guidance committee meets weekly with First 1000 Days director

Task force: Parent and community engagement -- to reach families of pre-schoolers who are in most need of services to help their children become school-ready by the time they start Kindergarten

- New flyer to recruit new B2K members distributed over social media as well as in print
- May/June survey to families with pre-schoolers to get input on their specific needs to help inform the work we do.

Task Force: Supporting the Early Childhood Educators Workforce

- Considering a grant for a WAGES pilot program that provides education-based salary supplements to low-paid teachers, directors and family child care providers.
- Local survey data of salary and benefits of ECE workforce is being compiled by Child & Family Resource staff.
- Considering a community-wide summit for early childhood educators.
- Considering a community-wide workshop on Resiliency Factors.

Task Force: Building Connections and Resource Sharing – to improve the way agencies and providers share referrals.

- Reviewed online community referral systems *Unite Us* and *211*, web-based platforms service providers can use to refer families to appropriate agencies and track progress. Data can be collected to track usage.
- Considering ways to promote awareness and adoption of these systems by local service providers.

Task Force: Data collection

- Discussion underway to revise the GPACE survey to be more concise and selective in what data is most useful to collect from families with pre-school children.
- The revised survey could be administered in discussions with parents at the Super Saturday breakfasts.
