Ontario County Youth Court

A restorative diversion that gives youth (grades 7-12) the opportunity to learn about the criminal justice system, be trained in the roles of the courtroom (judge, jury, prosecution, defense and bailiff) and then assume those roles in real court cases for youth offenders (respondents). Youth Court members review the case information, listen to witness testimony from the respondent and their families, and then work together to assign sanctions to the respondent that are restorative, not punitive. These sanctions are meant to help heal any damage or hurt that was caused by the crime that was committed and help the respondent rebuild positive connections within the community. To become a member of Ontario County Youth Court, youth must attend a 20 hour training course. This course is free and is being offered **August 4th-August 8th from 10am-2pm at FLCC**.
